2nd Peterborough Scout Group will be offering **Paddle Canada** (www.paddlecanada.com) Training for Scouters, Rovers & Venturers in 2018. This can be either training for those new to canoeing, or adding a formal certification to those with years of experience !

Two course types are offered (see Paddle Canada website for descriptions)....

- **Introduction to Lake Canoe Paddling** (8 hours)
- **Introduction to Canoe Tripping Skills** (2 days)

We have three courses planned....



Intro to Lake Canoe Paddling - for New Paddlers (4 evenings)

- **4 Monday evenings, May 28, June 4, 11, 18** from 6-8 PM each evening.
- At Beavermead Park (Ashburnham & Marsdale) in Peterborough, meet by the north parking boat launch.
- Cost is \$15 each, limited to 10 participants.
- We supply canoes, paddles, etc., you need proper clothing, and a PFD.
- You would need to attend all four evenings.
- Deadline to register is May 14, 2018, though please let us know earlier if possible.

Intro to Lake Canoe Paddling - for New Paddlers (1 day)

- **Saturday June 16** from 9 AM to 5 PM.
- At Beavermead Park (Ashburnham & Marsdale) in Peterborough, meet by the north parking boat launch.
- Cost is \$15 each, limited to 10 participants.
- We supply canoes, paddles, etc., you need proper clothing, a PFD, and a lunch.
- You would need to attend all day.
- Deadline to register is June 1, 2018, though please let us know earlier if possible.

Intro to Canoe Tripping Skills - for Experienced Paddlers (weekend)

- **Friday evening June 8 to Sunday afternoon June 10**
- At the Poker Lake system in the Township of Algonquin Highlands. We will launch & return to their "Big East Access Point" which is on Highway #118 about 20km west of Highway #35.
- Cost is \$35 each, limited to 8 participants.
- We supply canoes, paddles, etc., you need personal clothing, PFD, camping gear, meals, etc.
- Deadline to register is May 18, 2018, though please let us know earlier if possible.

If there is enough interest from those taking the "Intro to Lake Canoe Paddling" courses, we will add another "Intro to Canoe Tripping Skills" later in the Summer!

More details will be available when you sign up.

These can also be available to your Group / Sections on dates that you choose we can work on a schedule together.
